# SAINT LOUIS UNIVERSITY COLLEGE CREDIT EARNED IN HIGH SCHOOL

Saint Louis University welcomes the transfer of an unlimited number of college credits earned during high school. Generally, these credits take the form of Advanced Placement (AP) and/or dual enrollment credit. Your academic adviser will determine which credits are transferable to the University and how those credits will apply towards your degree.

Score reports and college transcripts should be submitted to the Office of Undergraduate Admission as soon as possible following confirmation of enrollment and before the start of the fall semester.

In some cases, receipt of your official score reports and college credit transcripts may not occur before your first meeting with an academic adviser at SLU 101. For this reason, you are strongly encouraged to maintain your own unofficial listing of college credits earned during high school so that you can discuss this information with your academic adviser and register for the appropriate courses.

- **Advanced Placement Credit:** Please request that an official score report be sent directly from AP Services to Saint Louis University. You may visit [www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/ap/exgrd\\_rep.html](http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/ap/exgrd_rep.html) or call AP Services at (888) 225-5427 to request score reports.

For information regarding the acceptance of AP scores and credit equivalency at SLU, please refer to the AP Chart included on the reverse of this flyer. Please note that not all AP examinations are accepted for credit by the University and that the score required for credit equivalency varies by exam.

- **Dual Enrollment Credit / Advanced College Credit:** Please request that an official, final transcript be sent directly from the college awarding the credit to Saint Louis University. Official college transcripts are required even if the coursework already appears on your high school transcript. Credits will be reviewed for transferability to Saint Louis University following receipt of official transcripts; you will have the opportunity to discuss the transferability of college credit with an academic adviser at your SLU 101 orientation.
- **Saint Louis University 1-8-1-8 Advanced College Credit:** Local students who have earned credit through Saint Louis University's 1-8-1-8 Advanced College Credit Program need not request that transcripts be sent as verification for those particular courses.
