### 1. **Books**

- GMAT 2006, Premier Program (Kaplan) Book and CD Rom (\$39)
- The Official Guide for GMAT Review (GMAC) Book (\$36.95)
- Cracking the GMAT with CD Rom (Princeton Review) Book and CD Rom (\$35.95)

### 2. **The Princeton Review** <http://testprep.princetonreview.com>

- Private Tutoring: (\$1000-3200)
- Classroom prep course (\$1249): 2-month course meets weekly at Wash U. Includes review books and 5 computer adaptive tests (CATs)
- GMAT LiveOnline (\$899): 5 live class sessions, online in real time with an extra 3 "help" sessions. Includes review books and 5 CATs with access to the program for 3 months. Time to complete program estimated at 50-70 hrs.
- GMAT Online (\$599): Review books and 4 CATs. 3-month access to the program with estimated completion in 40-60 hours.
- GMAT Express (\$99): Mini course offered if test is less than 3 weeks away. Online materials and 2 CATs. Estimated completion is 8 hrs.
  - All Princeton Review courses include a 1-year subscription to the Wall Street Journal, and a 6 month subscription to TIME.

- Private Tutoring: (\$2049-4049)
- Classroom course (\$1399): Meets twice a week for 5 weeks (9 class sessions total) at either SLU or the St. Louis Kaplan facility. Includes books, 4 CATs, and 7 practice tests.
- GMAT Premium Online (\$1199): Includes 8 CATs with 3 months unlimited access to review lessons online, take practice tests, and view supplemental workshops.
- GMAT Online (\$599): Includes diagnostic test with customized study plan with 3 months unlimited access.
- Crash Course (\$119): Mini course offered if test is less than 4 weeks away. Includes diagnostic test with study suggestions, 1 CAT.
- Question bank (1000 questions \$199): 24-hour access to question bank for 1-3 months to customize your own practice tests.
- Essay Grading GMAT (\$59): evaluation and feedback on how well you can analyze an argument or analyze an issue. Gives you direct advice on how to improve your score using ETS's standards.
