History

1888

Alvah Mansur purchased the property for \$10,400.

1897

Edgar and Lucy Ames purchased the property and constructed their home (the current building) for \$11,000. In years following, the property remained in the Ames estate.

1927

Herman and Adele Tegethoff purchased the house for \$100. It became a boarding house for Saint Louis University.

1946

Robert Stock and Paul Hammond purchased the building. It became Stock Florist.

1969

SLU alumni Gerald and Mary Deppe purchased the building. Deppe and Associates Advertising used the second floor as business offices; and remodeled the first floor for living space.

1992

SLU's Phi Delta Theta fraternity leased the house from the Deppes.

1996

Saint Louis University purchased the property from the Deppes' and renovated it to create a faculty and alumni club.

1998

Bannister House, named for University alumnus, trustee and benefactor Joseph P. Bannister, opens as a restaurant on February 16, 1998.
