If you already submitted a portfolio as part of the admission process, you do not need to submit again for scholarships.

The Studio Art portfolio review process uses SlideRoom, an online review system. Applicants register and submit their portfolio on the SlideRoom website using SLU's portal: <https://slu.slideroom.com>. SlideRoom is web-based, so all applicants need is an Internet connection and a modern web browser - and applicants with prepared digital files can quickly upload their portfolio within minutes.
