- 3 A discussion of the development of your work (vocation) history, including a chronological list of positions and dates.
- 4 An account of an incident in which you were called on to help someone, including the nature of the request assessment of the “problem,” what you did, and a summary evaluation. A CPE-type verbatim is encouraged and preferred especially in applications for units after applicant’s first unit of CPE. [1 – 3 pages]
- 5 Your impression of Clinical Pastoral Education and your educational goals, including how you anticipate this training will be used to meet your goals for future ministry. [1– 2 pages]

For those with previous CPE units:

- 1 Copies of previous CPE unit evaluations (yours and your supervisor’s)—if you have done CPE prior to this.
- 2 What was the most significant learning experience in previous CPE and how have you continued to work in this learning method? Illustrate your strengths and weaknesses as a professional person.
- 3 What are your personal and professional goals and how will continued training aid that process?

A **\$50.00** (fifty dollar) fee for application and interview, payable to the **St. Louis Cluster, ACPE**. Upon receipt of the application and fees, materials will be reviewed by Cluster supervisors and the applicant will be contacted regarding an interview.
