

Logistics to Meet Technology Requirement for CTE Certificate Participants

The requirement as approved by the CTE advisory board reads:

“Demonstrate competency in selecting and integrating an appropriate teaching technology. Documentation will include a summary of the planned technology application and reflection based on feedback from mentors and peers.”

The CTE will provide support for certificate participants in the exploration of a variety of widely used learning technologies through face-to-face and online seminars.

Since technology use varies widely by discipline and individual instructor/learner preference, the participant may fulfill the technology requirement by incorporating discipline-specific learning technology, such as software used in engineering or medicine. The CTE will generally not be able to provide support in discipline-specific technologies.

The process for participants

1. Participant enrolls in and actively takes part in online seminar “Getting Started with Learning Technologies.” This workshop will be held at least three times during fall and spring semesters. Enrollment will be announced on the CTE e-mail list and at regularly scheduled Effective Teaching Seminars.
2. Upon completion of the seminar, participant develops a lesson plan incorporating a discipline-appropriate learning technology. This would involve development of technology object such as, web-based materials, Blackboard course site, blog, wiki or podcast.
3. The student includes a short reflection relating their use of technology to their teaching philosophy and their lesson plan in the portfolio.
