Communicating in Chinese I

(CHIN 110-01 MWF 10:00-10:50)

(CHIN 110-02 MWF 11:00-11:50)

An introductory course designed for true beginners. Students who take this course will learn about Chinese culture as well as master basic pronunciation (pinyin) and the grammatical structure of spoken Chinese. You will have a vocabulary of 400 lexical items and be able to comprehend enough spoken Chinese to survive in simple daily conversations.

Communicating in Chinese II

(CHIN 115-01 MWF 12:00-12:50)

An intermediate course designed for students who have the basics of Chinese (e.g. pinyin, four tones). The course emphasis is on listening, speaking, reading, and basic writing skills. Students will build a large vocabulary and improve daily spoken Chinese, enabling students to use Chinese comfortably in making travel arrangements, business appointments, etc. Additionally, the course will integrate Chinese culture into the learning process to enhance the practice of Chinese.

Intermediate Chinese: Language & Culture I

(CHIN 210-01 MWF 2:10-3:00)

For students who have successfully completed 110 and 115 or the equivalent from another institution. This course will enable the student to master a vocabulary of 800 lexical items and be able to proficiently communicate, read and write Chinese.



Intermediate Chinese: Language & Culture II

(CHIN 215-01 MWF 3:10-4:00)

This course is designed for students who have already successfully completed 210 I or have other relevant experience. Aside from spoken Chinese, it also covers readings in Chinese literature, culture and history. Students will become proficient in Chinese in order to read simple Chinese short stories and newspapers.
