- Dr. Ana Montero presented two papers during her sabbatical leave last semester. The first was “Aristotle’s *Nicomachean Ethics* and Sentimental Romance in Castile at the end of the fifteenth century: *Repetición de amores* by Luis de Lucena” at the Illinois Medieval Association & Medieval Association of the Mid-West Congress, Dominican University, Chicago, February 18-20, 2010. Her second paper was “*Diálogo de Epicteto y el emperador Adriano: ¿un testimonio de heterodoxia en Castilla?*” at the Association canadienne de hispanistes. Concordia University, Montreal, Canada, May 29-30, 2010.
- Dr. Julia Lieberman delivered a paper entitled, "A Document on Jewish Daily Life in Jerusalem in the 1630s" at the British Conference on Judeo-Spanish Studies that took place on July 12 through July 15, 2010, at Queen Mary University of London, UK.
