

Research Assistantship in Madrid, Spain.

All qualified full-time students who already hold a Teaching or Research Assistantship in our Saint Louis Graduate Program can apply for a one-semester Research Assistantship in Madrid, Spain.

Requirements:

- Completion of at least 12 credit hours of graduate level courses with a GPA of 3.7 (or special permission by the Spanish Graduate Program Director).
- Completion of a year (two semesters) of residency at our Saint Louis campus.
- A proposal describing the Academic Research Project to be conducted in Madrid (proposal format will be provided).
- Agreement from a Madrid faculty member to serve as research supervisor during the student's semester in Madrid.
- Two letters of recommendation submitted to the Director of the Spanish Graduate Program.
- Approval by the Director of the Spanish Graduate Program, the Chair of MCL and the Graduate School.
- At the end of the one-semester assistantship, the student submits an outcomes report to the Director of the Spanish Graduate Program. Format will be provided.

The Spanish Division will periodically evaluate the functioning of this program.
