

Policies of the 310-level

SP-A 310 Enrollment Prerequisites:

Successful completion of Spanish 210 or its equivalent, placement examination, or permission of the Level Coordinator. All students must take the Placement Test, and turn the results in the last day of the first week of classes.

Spanish Events:

SP 310 students must attend at least two films, lectures or cultural events in Spanish (preferably scheduled by the Spanish House).

SLU Inquiry Students:

SP-A 310 Inquiry students are required to volunteer eight hours of community service learning as a minimum. Volunteer work can be done with the Southside Catholic Charities, La Clínica, Acción Social Comunitaria, SSM Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital, Kingdom House (Immigrant and Refugee Outreach: CHobart@kingdomhouse.org) or any other organization where students can use their knowledge of Spanish to help others. Written evidence of the satisfactory completion of the requirement has to be signed by the volunteer institution and turned in to the instructor a week before finishing the semester. Informal evidence is not acceptable. The final grade reported for students not completing this requirement is I (Incomplete). The grade will be changed as soon as the student provides the written evidence.
