

Senior Inquiry for Spanish Majors

The requirements for the Senior Inquiry for Spanish Majors is as follows:

- Each student will write a double-spaced paper of 15 pages. Five to six pages are to be presented at the Annual Undergraduate Symposium.
- The topic of the paper may be connected with any of the upper-level Spanish courses (beyond 420) that the student is taking or has taken.
- The professor of the course from which the student chooses his or her topic will authorize the student's participation in the Symposium based on the research and compositional quality of the paper.
- In order to fulfill these requirements, it is appropriate that the professors create in their classes a symposium atmosphere. Students should become acquainted with the first requirement for participation: the abstract or proposal. Advisors should also make students aware of the requirements of the Senior Inquiry.
