



## Bioengineering at Saint Louis University - BE@SLU Research Experience for Undergraduates

We invite applications for a nine week summer research program in bioengineering sponsored by the National Science Foundation REU Program. Details of the REU program, our department, and project descriptions can be found at the website:

The NSF-sponsored (funding pending) program is specifically targeted at early career undergraduates, including those who are entering their first or second years in college. Students currently in their sophomore year are also eligible to apply. The program will run for nine consecutive weeks, beginning May 31, 2010 through July 30, 2010. Students in the program will receive a stipend of \$4050 in addition to housing, a food subsidy and partial travel expenses for non-local participants.

**REQUIREMENTS:** Students interested in the program must be enrolled as an undergraduate for Fall 2010. All students should have a demonstrated interest in bioengineering. Applications are especially encouraged from students at institutions where research is not available to undergraduates, students who are underrepresented in engineering and science in the US, and students with disabilities. Participants must be US citizens or permanent residents of the USA.
