Candidates should have a master's or doctoral degree in public health, public policy, economics, or a related field and a good working knowledge of U.S. health policy. Between 3 and 5 years of experience in health policy will be a plus. This position will support policy research initiatives on antibiotic resistance and antibiotic use. Candidates should be well organized, be able to independently manage tasks, and have excellent communications and writing skills. Mathematical modeling, statistical analysis, and computer programming are also desirable skills for this position.

We offer a one-year appointment beginning in September 2008 with the expectation of a three-year tenure. Salary is competitive.
