Performing Arts Minor – 18 credits Minimum GPA required: 2.00

Overview: Students in the Fine & Performing Arts minor will choose an **area of concentration** out of **Theatre, Dance, or Music.** They will take courses in that area and at least one additional one to a total of **18 credits** divided in three sections: introductory course, concentration requirements, and elective courses.

**The capstone must be related to the student's concentration area and be taken towards the end of the minor. You will present a final solo or group capstone performance lasting between 10 and 20 minutes that displays what has been learned through the minor. This could be a theatre work, a monologue, a solo or ensemble musical recital, a dance piece or a musical theatre piece.

Transfer courses: Students can transfer up to 4 credits to count towards concentration or elective requirements.
