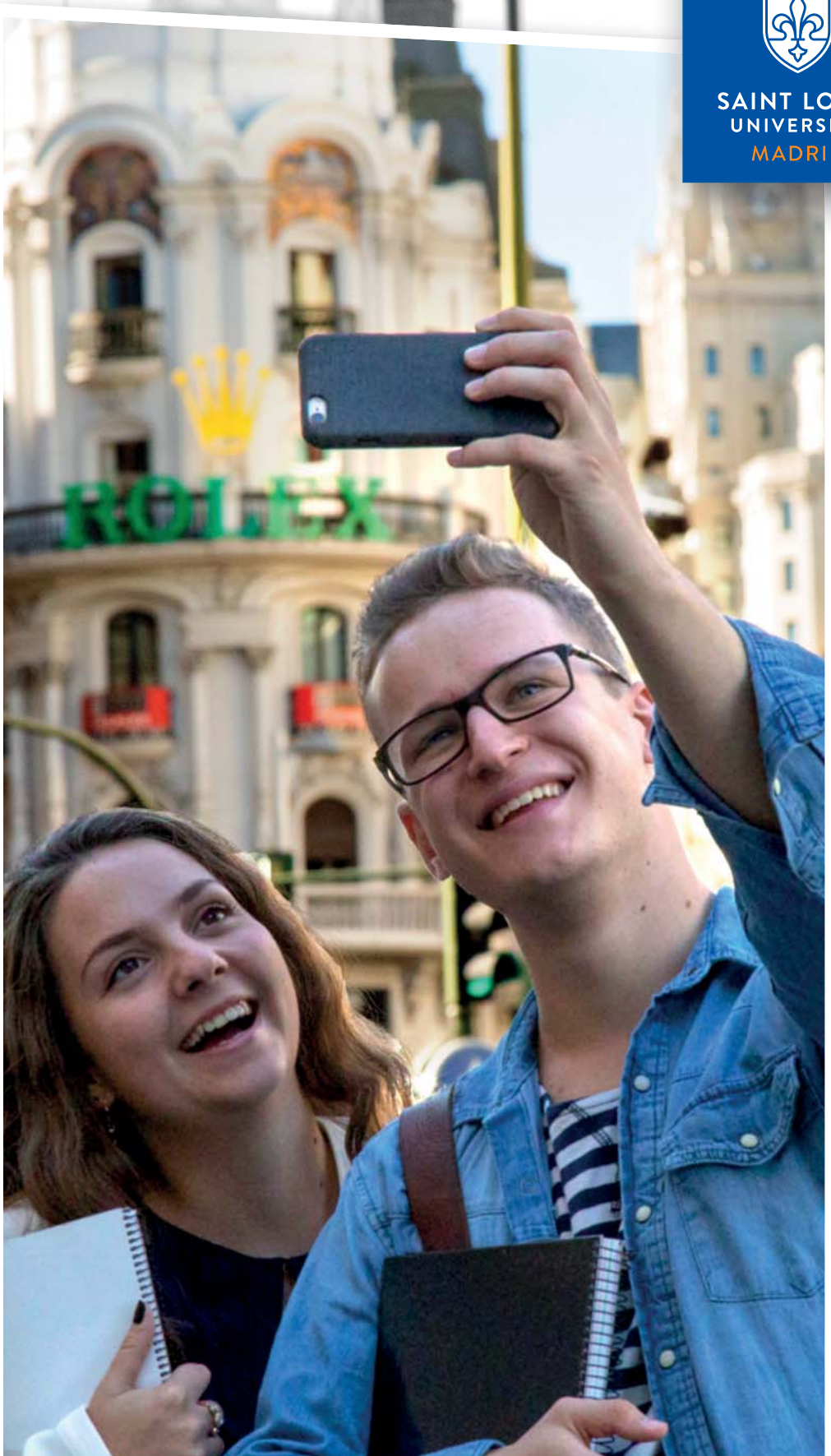

Summer Session 2018 *May 21 - June 21*

Intensive Spanish Summer Session *June 25- July 26*

This summer, earn credits toward your degree while you experience life in a new culture. At SLU-Madrid, we offer more than 50 fully accredited classes during the Summer Session 2018 (May 21-June 21) and the Intensive Spanish Summer Session (June 25-July 26). Summer classes normally meet from Monday through Thursday for five weeks. All classes fulfill Saint Louis University degree requirements.

For engineering students: CVNG 2017 Spain's Civil Architectural Infrastructure: Ancient and Modern. A study of civil engineering and construction practices within the Spanish civilization, with emphasis on comparisons of the old and the new. Includes a 2-week field trip in the Spanish countryside to visit aqueducts, canals, dams, bridges, and highways. Extra fees apply. Dates: May 21 - June 3. 1 credit.

For nursing students: NURS 3930: Madrid Summer Immersion Program. An intensive learning experience in clinical nursing for Spanish-speaking students. Under the guidance of an experienced Spanish nurse mentor/preceptor employed at a healthcare center or hospital in Spain, you will have the opportunity to increase your knowledge about health care delivery and the role of nursing in Spain. Dates: May 21 - June 21. 3 credits.

For student athletes: "No Spain, No Gain"— Earn credits towards your degree and keep up with your training. Our Sports Director advises student athletes on where to work out. Discounts at local gyms are available for students as well.

Do you love to travel and explore? Sign up for a class with a fieldwork component! Travel to the Mediterranean coast with your oceanography class. Visit local markets with your Spanish conversation class. Browse Madrid's world-renowned art museums to see the works by Dalí and Velázquez that you are studying in your art history class.

Apply Early! Course registration opens on February 14, 2018. Some special courses and programs have earlier application deadlines. Students requiring visas to enter Spain should apply for a visa at least two months prior to the first day of classes. Find out more at www.slu.edu/madrid/summer.

Tuition and Fees: Summer tuition is about 50% lower than fall and spring semester tuition. The Summer 2017 rate was 490 euros (\$540, based on the March 1, 2017 exchange rate) per credit; 2018 tuition and housing rates will be posted online in February 2018.

Housing: Host family housing as well as options in Spanish dorms/residence halls and apartments are available.
