6 ☐ SOS Hours and Make up

If you did not attend SOS and notified Ashley beforehand, you will receive an e-mail letting you know that you have been excused but you must do/have done ONE of the following three make ups:

1. Attend an Episodic Site throughout the semester that was at least 3 hours long
2. Be on the SOS Committee
3. Work the Fundraising Event on May 2nd at Chaifetz

If you did not attend SOS and did not notify Ashley then you are simply put on probation since SOS is a requirement. This means you must complete all requirements next semester to remain active in APO. You will also receive an e-mail at the end of the year informing you of your status.
