



Certified Safety & Health Official (CSHO)

This certificate program requires a minimum of eight (8) OSHA courses and is the next step to taken after obtaining your SSH. You can choose from the General Industry or Construction Industry Certification Track. Complete all of the required courses in your chosen track as well as two (2) electives. Courses can be applied toward advanced level certifications (SHEP). Transfer up to two (2) required courses from any OSHA Training Institute Education Center outside of OSHA Region VII (Midwest). The certification costs \$75 and there is no time limit in which the courses must be completed.
