What is a summer financial aid application?

- A summer financial aid application is how you notify our office that you wish to have consideration for a financial aid package for the 2009 summer term.

What aid might be included in summer financial aid package?

- SLU Undergraduate scholarships are not applied during the summer terms. Students eligible for Stafford Loan funds will be packaged with remaining eligibility. Students who have utilized the Stafford Loan eligibility for the 2008-2009 academic year may be able to borrow a Parent Plus loan, private/alternative loan Or a Graduate Plus loan (for Graduate/Professional Students).

Why do I need to complete this form?

- Upon completion of this form, including expected enrollment and meeting all eligibility criteria, an award letter will be sent back to you via your SLU email account and/or US mail indicating your eligibility and/or processed aid for summer 2009.

NOTE: You must file your 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before consideration.

**FAQ's For Summer 2009 Financial Aid**

**Who is Eligible?**

The majority of summer aid programs will require enrollment of at least half-time in a degree granting or eligible certificate program at Saint Louis University (SLU). Please see the table listed below.

\* If you do **not** plan to enroll in summer school, but you will be enrolled half-time in a degree granting or eligible certificate program at SLU during the Fall 2009 semester, you may be eligible to receive Federal Work Study.

**What is Available?**

Most applicants are able to borrow to cover certified summer school costs through various loan programs. There is limited funding in certain programs, such as Perkins and Federal Work Study.

**Application Requirements**

- Submit 2009 Summer Financial Aid Application
- File (or already filed) the 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) no later than June 30, 2009.
- Students not enrolled for summer classes may be eligible for Federal Work Study **ONLY**; these applicants must file the 2009-2010 FAFSA and have met all mandatory requirements.

**Application Deadlines**

- Priority will be given to students who submit a completed 2009 Summer Application by June 1, 2009.
- Summer aid decisions will be communicated to students as processed and continue on a rolling basis as applications are received.
- Applicants who have not already completed a 2008-2009 FAFSA must do so by June 30, 2009.

**Disbursement of Summer Aid**
