2008 Summer Financial Aid Application

What is a summer financial aid application?

- ✓ A summer financial aid application is how you notify our office that you wish to have consideration for a financial aid package for the 2008 summer term. Upon completion of this form, including expected enrollment and meeting all eligibility criteria, an award letter will be sent back to you via your SLU email account and/or US mail indicating your eligibility and/or processed aid for summer 2008.

What will my summer financial aid package look like?

- ✓ SLU Undergraduate scholarships are not applied during the summer terms. Students eligible for Stafford Loan funds will be packaged with remaining eligibility (see reverse for details). Students who have utilized the Stafford Loan eligibility for the 2007-2008 academic year may borrow a Parent Plus as (Undergrad), Graduate Plus loan (for Graduate/Professional Students). After the FLP Parent Plus and Graduate Plus programs have been exhausted a private/alternative loan is a final option.

NOTE: You must file your 2007-2008 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before consideration.

FAQ's For Summer 2008 Financial Aid

Who is Eligible?

The majority of summer aid programs will require enrollment of at least half-time in a degree granting or eligible certificate program at Saint Louis University (SLU). Please see the table listed below. * If you do **not** plan to enroll in summer school, but you will be enrolled full-time in a degree granting or eligible certificate program at SLU during the Fall 2008 semester, you may be eligible to receive Federal Work-Study only.

What is Available?

Most applicants are able to borrow to meet certified summer school costs through various loan programs. There is limited funding in certain programs, such as Perkins and Federal Work-Study.

Application Requirements

- Submit 2008 Summer Financial Aid Application
- File (or already filed) the 2007-2008 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Students not enrolled for summer classes may be eligible for Federal Work-Study only; these applicants must file the 2008-2009 FAFSA.

Application Deadlines

- Priority processing will be given to students who submit a completed 2008 Summer Application by July 1, 2008.
- Summer aid decisions will be communicated to students beginning May 15, 2008 and continue on a rolling basis as applications are received.
- Applicants who have not already completed a 2007-2008 FAFSA must do so by June 30, 2008.

Disbursement of Summer Aid
