How Does it Work?

- Enroll as a **Communication** major
- Complete between 15-48 credits, then apply to join the 3+3 program
- Maintain a **3.5 GPA**
- After completing 75 credits, apply to SLU Law
- Begin J.D. program in 4th year as an undergraduate
- Law school coursework in that 4th year counts as elective credit towards B.A. in Communication
- After the successful completion of the first year of law school, SLU awards a bachelor's degree

Why Pursue the Accelerated Program?

- Many students use **Communication** as a springboard for the study of **law**. The skills in writing, speaking, critical thinking, and building arguments that students learn in their **Communication** classes prepare students well to thrive in law school.
