Message from Core Ignite Seminar Director

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Dear SLU colleagues,

Over 275 of this fall's first-year students are "early adopters" of the Core and are taking one of our 13 pilot Ignite Seminars. In addition to these 13, the University Undergraduate Core Committee (UUCC) has approved an additional 34 Ignite Seminar submissions for a total of 47 to be offered in our Core launch year 2022-2023. Our plan last Fall was to secure these 13 for the Pilot year, and to make significant headway on the 80 that we will likely need in the launch year. **What this means for you is that we need more Ignite Seminar submissions!**

Our plan for this Fall is to secure our remaining needs for the 2022-2023 launch year, and have a significant number approved and ready to go in advance of the 2023-2024 academic year. **The portal for faculty to submit proposals** for the Ignite First Year Seminar to be offered in the 2022-2023 and/or the 2023-2024 academic years is now open, wand will remain open until October 15th. Additionally, the Cura Personalis and Reflection in Action Submission Portals are now open. Please note that courses with Cura Personalis 2 or Reflection in Action as an attribute, along with Cura Personalis 3 courses taught as lab sections to an existing course, should still be submitted using the traditional Courseleaf method at https://courseleaf.slu.edu/courseadmin/. All Cura Personalis and Reflection in Action components may be taught by a faculty or staff member with a Master's degree of higher.
