Purpose: To recognize faculty members for outstanding career achievements in research and/or creative activity

Eligibility: Full-time faculty who have made significant contributions to scholarship and research while employed by Saint Louis University. Award recipients are eligible once every five years.

Criteria: Documented evidence of outstanding research/creative accomplishments, impact of work in his or her discipline as evaluated by peers and experts in the field, and outstanding national and international recognition in the academic community. The candidates will be evaluated by members of the Selection Committee and the Awards Committee.

Nominations may be submitted by anyone, including the nominee themselves. Nominations, including self-nominations, should be submitted to Sue McGahan, Awards Committee Chair, by February 16, 2018. The nominee along with his/her department chairperson will be notified by the Awards Committee. The nominee will be requested to compile all required documentation in a single submission packet. Completed packets are due March 19, 2018.

Submission Materials including the following:

1. A key component to a good application packet is a synthesis of the nominee's accomplishments and their impact on the nominee's discipline. Begin with a statement describing why the applicant's scholarly contributions make him or her eligible candidate for this award. Cite specific examples or relevant accomplishments including, but not limited to: peer-reviewed publications/presentations, grants, patents, etc. and give examples of recognition that demonstrate the impact of these accomplishments in the applicant's discipline.

2. Include a CV.
3. Provide no more than three brief support letters from colleagues who are in a position to comment on the applicant's research/creative activity. At least one letter must be external to Saint Louis University.

Award Recipient will receive the following:

1. A certificate in recognition of their scholarship/research
2. A letter of recognition from the Dean
3. A featured article on the DCHS website
4. \$250 that may be used for professional development (i.e., travel, professional dues, books, software, etc.) in FY18.

Awards will be presented during the DCHS Faculty and Staff Awards Reception on May 3, 2018.

The deadline for nominations is February 16, 2018 and the deadline for application packets is March 19, 2018.
