**Qualifications:** Applicants must have successfully applied and been accepted as a classified degree-seeking (fully admitted) student into the Master of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics program. **Responsibilities:** Graduate teaching assistants are expected to provide 20 hours each week toward the clinical, instructional, food service, research or other assignments within the Department. This could include assisting with various health promotion programs and/or clinical instruction. GA's are required to register for nine (9) credit hours of graduate course work or research each semester of an award.

**Compensation:** Stipend plus tuition scholarship for 18 credit hours (9 hours fall / 9 hours spring) and health insurance.
