## Building Access

Pius XII Memorial Library provides access to current SLU students, staff, and faculty; guests escorted by a current SLU student, staff, or faculty member; alumni; Library Associates; MOBIUS affiliates; visiting scholars sponsored by a SLU department; attendees of SLU-sponsored events or conferences; users of the Federal Depository Library collection; and visiting researchers by appointment only.

## Borrowing Privileges

Current Saint Louis University students, staff, and faculty; MOBIUS affiliates; Library Associates and other courtesy borrowers may borrow materials with a valid ID.

## Library Account Access

Copies with the status, "Not Checked Out" will be available to requesters sooner if requesters are able to retrieve the items from the shelves themselves. Copies that are currently checked-out will display a due date.

## MOBIUS & PROSPECTOR Consortia

SLU participates in multiple borrowing consortia that provide access to academic and public library collections from across Missouri, Illinois, Iowa, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Colorado. Items not currently available through the SLU library catalog can easily be requested through the MOBIUS or PROSPECTOR catalogs:

When items are received at Pius Library, requesters will be notified to pick up the books at the Patron Services Desk. From the notice date, SLU items are held for 7 days and MOBIUS/PROSPECTOR items are held 10 days for pickup.

## Print Reserves

Traditional print reserve materials are available at the Patron Services Desk and include items identified by faculty for individual courses, as well as items on permanent reserve.

## Electronic Reserves

Access to materials on E-Reserves is available from the E-Reserves web page either by the instructor's name or the course name or course number and is limited by password to students enrolled in each course. E-Reserve course pages are removed at the end of each semester.

## STUDY SPACES

Pius XII Memorial Library provides 20 single occupancy study rooms and 26 collaborative spaces of various sizes that are reservable up to 7 days in advance. Reservations can be made using the online reservation system DIBS:

Non-reservable spaces are available throughout the 6 levels of Pius proper and 4 levels of the Lewis Annex, including a graduate student lounge on the 3rd floor of Pius.
