

Connecting to Billiken Wired

Registering your non-computer device to the Residential Network at SLU

Step by Step

1. **Plug** your device into the **Residential Network Jack**,
 - a. Please note, the Residential Network Jack is the colored port (blue, purple, green, etc) to the right or bottom on the face place. The beige port is an old phone line that will not work.
2. **Find** and **write down** your devices' **Ethernet Physical or MAC Address**
 - a. This would be found under Settings -> Network
 - b. The MAC address is a string of six sets of two-digits or characters, separated by colons
3. On your Computer, **open** a web browser
4. **Go to** Resnetreg.slu.edu
5. **Check** the **SLU acceptable Use Policy box** and **Click Start**, F1
6. **Log-in** with **SLU Net ID** and **SLU Net Password**, **Click Continue**, F2
7. **Click Register A Different Device**, F3
8. **Type** the **Mac/Physical Address**
9. **Click Continue**
10. **After** getting the **Thank you for Registering Screen**, F4
11. **Wait 5 minutes** and **restart** your **device**. The device should connect to the Ethernet now.

Not getting networking?

- Make sure to use the colored port on your jack. Look for the green, blue or purple port. The beige port is the old phone line and DOES NOT provide networking.

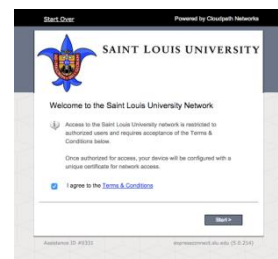
Getting a time out error?

- Restart your device.

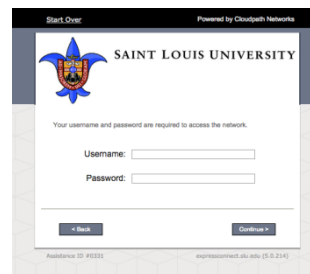
Having Problems registering?

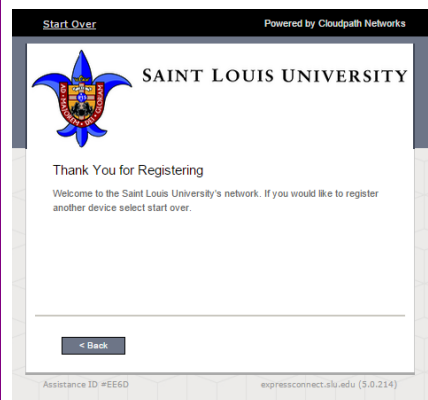
F1: SLU Acceptable Use Policy
