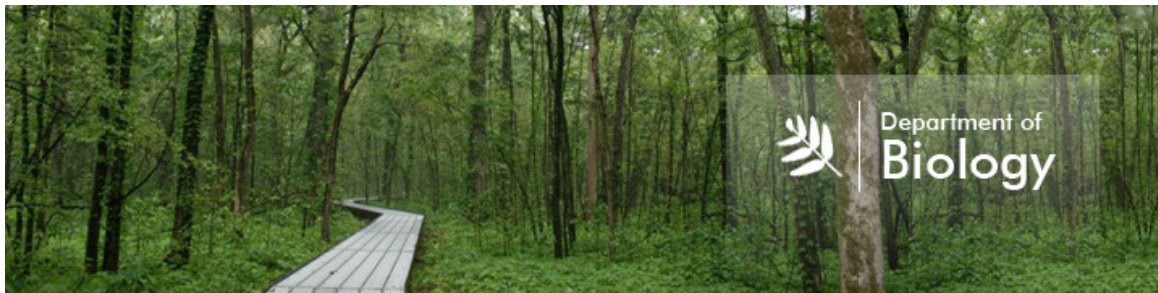

MINOR IN BIOLOGY



The Division of Sciences & Engineering offers students the opportunity to pursue a course of study leading to a Minor in Biology. The minor has been designed to provide students with a broad background in biology and is an excellent complement to any major related to Natural Sciences, Biomedical Engineering, Health Sciences, and Pre-medicine.

Requirements

The Minor in Biology can be completed at SLU-Madrid by students who complete 8 hours of introductory biology, 8 hours of introductory chemistry, and 12 hours of upper division biology courses.

Prerequisites for a Minor in Biology (16 hours)

- 8 hours of introductory biology (BIOL 1240/1245 and BIOL 1260/1265)
- 8 hours of introductory chemistry (CHEM 1110/1115 and CHEM 1120/1125)

Upper Division Biology courses (12 hours)

- BIOL-3020 Cellular Biochemistry and Molecular Biology
- BIOL-3040 Cellular Structure and Function
- CHEM-3600 Principles of Biochemistry
- Upper Division online course. The student should get approval for a specific on-line course to be counted prior to taking it to avoid problems with the course articulation.
