To be certified for graduation, a student is required to...

- Complete no less than 120 credits, including 30 credits in the English major (beyond the 6 credits of literature required in the core);
- Have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA, a 2.0 English GPA, and a 2.0 GPA in the minor or second major;
- Complete 30 of his or her final 36 hours at Saint Louis University (Of these 30 hours, especially for transfer students, a minimum of 18 hours of coursework must be taken within the English major).
- Submit the on-line degree application at the beginning of the semester in which he or she intends to graduate.
