Apply Early! Course registration opens on February 12, 2019. Some special courses and programs have earlier application deadlines. Students requiring visas to enter Spain should apply for a visa at least two months prior to the first day of classes.

Admission Requirements: For admission and English language requirements, please see our web page.

Tuition and Fees: Summer tuition is about 50% lower than fall and spring semester tuition. The Summer 2018 rate was 520 euros (\$630, based on the March 1, 2018 exchange rate) per credit; 2019 tuition and housing rates will be posted online in February 2019.

Housing: Host family housing as well as options in Spanish dorms/residence halls and apartments are available.
