

SCHOLARSHIPS

A guide to SLU-Madrid's scholarships and merit-based awards.

MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

First-year students

All new first-year students are considered for our merit-based scholarships, which are awarded on the basis of academic achievement. No separate scholarship application is required.

- The **Borja Scholarship** has an annual value of 1,500 € (total four-year value of 6,000 €)
- The **Rubio Scholarship** has an annual value of 3,000 € (total four-year value of 12,000 €)
- The **Arrupe Scholarship** has an annual value of 5,000 € (total four-year value of 20,000 €)
- The **Sullivan Scholarship** has an annual value of 7,000 € (total eight semester value of 28,000 €)
- The **Iñigo Scholarship** has an annual value of 9,200 € (total eight semester value of 36,800 €)

Additionally, SLU-Madrid offers the **Director's Scholarship**, a four-year, full-tuition award valid only on the Madrid Campus. First-year applicants who meet the following minimum requirements are invited to fill out a separate application for Director's Scholarship candidacy:

- Cumulative high school GPA of 3.85 or higher, weighted or unweighted, as reported on your transcript at the time of submission of the Director's Scholarship application essay.
- Official test score of at least 30 (composite) on the ACT or a 1390 (total score) on the SAT (or a 1330, math + critical reasoning, if taken prior to March 2016).

Transfer students

All transfer students are eligible for our merit-based scholarships for transfer students. No separate scholarship application is required.

- The **Javier I Scholarship** has an annual value of 4,600 € (total three-year value of 13,800 €)
- The **Javier II Scholarship** has an annual value of 5,600 € (total three-year value of 16,800 €)
- The **Javier III Scholarship** has a per semester value of 6,600 € (total three-year value of 19,800 €)

OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS

Madrid Campus Catholic High School Scholarship

Entering first-year, degree-seeking students who have completed their last two years of high school at a Catholic high school owned or operated by a Catholic order anywhere in the world are given the Madrid Campus **Catholic High School Award** with an annual value of 2,000 €.

Madrid Campus Jesuit High School Scholarship

Entering first-year, degree-seeking students who have completed their last two years of high school at a Jesuit high school anywhere in the world are given the Madrid Campus **Jesuit High School Award** with an annual value of 2,500 €.

Madrid Campus Antiguos Alumnos Award

The Madrid Campus **Antiguos Alumnos Award** is automatically granted to all entering first-year students who submit documentation confirming to be the dependent child of SLU alumni who have attended at least one full academic year on the Madrid Campus. This scholarship has an annual value of 1,500 €.

Family Award

Family Awards of 1,500 € per year are available for families with more than one dependent child enrolled simultaneously at Saint Louis University (St. Louis and/or Madrid Campus).

Students who decide to transfer to SLU's St. Louis Campus, and have maintained their scholarships on the Madrid Campus, will continue to receive a corresponding scholarship as published.

The annual value of all awards is credited in two equal parts toward fall and spring semester tuition costs.
