Report sexual assault (whether within the SLU-Madrid community or between a SLU-Madrid community member and a person outside SLU-Madrid) to The Director of Student Life for them to get the help they need.

Faculty and staff should contact the Director of Student Life to report the information. For the student to be provided with all the information about all type of resources.

Reporting information to the Director of Student Life:

- Provides adequate support and resources to the victim;
- Helps protect the safety of the victim, the safety of any student(s) involved and the entire campus community;
- Student Life may have information about the incident and/or the accused that you may not be aware of.

Note: Without a Police report and by Spanish Law, gynecologists in Spain will not check you up if you say you have been victim of a sexual assault..

In the EU: Call **112** if you are anywhere in the EU and follow their guidelines.

In SPAIN (but not in Madrid): call **112** and request the National Police or dial **091** for guidelines.

In MADRID:

You may call **112; 091** or the 24/7 **Servicio De Atención A La Mujer (SAM)** at: (+34) 91 322 35 55

You may walk in just after the incident and/or within the first 72 hours and without a shower: You must go personally to :

After reporting at the SAM, **go to Hospital Universitario La Paz** at Paseo de la Castellana, 261 (28046 Madrid) for them to obtain forensic evidence.
