Criteria

Webster University Graduate Student Award Nominations

Webster University Graduate Award is designed to acknowledge a graduate student or new master's graduate from Webster University Department of Nursing who has demonstrated excellence, academically and clinically.

Nominees for these awards must be a Chapter member, or eligible for Chapter membership. The nominee must be currently enrolled in, and have successfully completed, 50% of their required program. Upon acceptance into the Chapter, their nomination for an award will be considered with all others. Chapter members and eligible persons, who have graduated since the presentation of the previous year's awards, may be considered.

To be eligible for award consideration, the nominee must be recommended by two Chapter members, or recommended by one Chapter member and endorsed by a second Chapter member. One of these members must be a Webster University Department of Nursing Faculty member who has been involved in the nominee's educational experience.

The review of nominees will be blinded. Selection of the award recipient will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. A cumulative GPA of 3.50 in graduate study.
- 2. Demonstrated excellence in each of the following areas:
 - A. Synthesis of theoretical knowledge
 - B. Leadership
 - C. Promotes utilization of nursing research in practice
 - D. Professional, community, or University service

The graduate Award will be presented to the nominee who best meets the above criteria.
