

Student Learning Outcomes Report: ABSN Option 2019-2020

The Accelerated BSN Option (ABSN) of the Pre-licensure Program at Saint Louis University assessed Student Learning Outcomes 9,10,11,12 and 13 during the 2019-20 academic year. Data for the assessment (clinical evaluation tools, HESI Exit scores, and course assignments) were collected directly through the course faculty members. NCLEX pass rates and data from the Sky Factor Assessment Tool Data will be provided by the Associate Dean for Undergraduate Pre-Licensure Programs in winter of 2021. The results from these findings will be reviewed by the ABSN faculty in August, 2020 during the curriculum review meeting. At that time, recommendations for improvement (where needed) will be formulated and presented at the Undergraduate Pre-Licensure Program Committee (UPPC) meeting.
