Dear Saint Louis University community,

I am writing to update you on an extension to the withdrawal deadline for the current semester and the 2022-23 academic calendar.

Extension to spring 2022 "W" date

Similar to the fall semester, we are extending **the course withdrawal deadline for the spring 2022 semester**: for courses in the main 16-week semester, the original "W" date was Sunday, April 3 -- it is being extended to Sunday, May 8, 2022.

I want to encourage all students who may be struggling with a course this spring to speak with their faculty mentors and academic advisors about the W option, and what it would mean for their degree progression. It might -- or might not -- be an appropriate decision. Please seek professional guidance to understand the implications of this choice.

2022-23 Academic calendar

The calendar for the next academic year (2022-2023) is now available on the [Registrar's website](#) and in the [attached PDF](#). I want to call everyone's attention to some key items about the calendar, specifically a few additional days and times off that we built into the calendar in advance.

- **Thursday, September 1, 2022**: the Mass of the Holy Spirit will take place at 11 am at College Church. All classes scheduled during that time will be canceled.
- **Wednesday, September 28, 2022**: this will be a scheduled well-being day for the fall semester for all undergraduate and graduate students, *except those in the School of Law and School of Medicine, whose accreditation and other restrictions prevent canceling class. Additionally, some professional programs with clinical rotation commitments or specialized learning experiences may continue in cases where they cannot be rescheduled. Students in these areas will hear from their Dean if their educational activities will still be held.*
- **Friday, February 10, 2023**: this will be a scheduled well-being day for the spring semester for all undergraduate and graduate students, *except for those in the same situations mentioned above.*
