These Fellowships are designed to make Graduate level education more accessible to students with an interest and passion for Social Justice. Students first apply to the School of Social Work to be considered for nomination. Once applications are reviewed by School of Social Work, one student will be chosen for Fellowship nomination to the Office of Graduate Education. Final decisions on awardees will be made by the Office of Graduate Education.

Eligibility

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or a Lawful Permanent Resident if applying for the Diversity Fellowship
- Must be accepted as a Classified Full-time Graduate Degree-seeking student at Saint Louis University
- Must be a new Post-Baccalaureate student with no more than one semester completed in a Post-Baccalaureate program

Criteria

- Demonstration of outstanding scholastic achievement
- Demonstration of potential success in graduate school
- Demonstration of professional experience through employment, teaching, and/or research experience
 - Volunteer experience or service experience (Americorps, Peace Corps, etc.)
 - o Leadership experience/involvement in professional/scholastic organizations

- ✓ One Letter of Recommendation Specifically for Fellowship
- ✓ Essay describing why you think you make the best candidate to receive a fellowship
