# Finding a direct equivalent to a SLU course


Example: You want to take an equivalent course to SLU's MATH 1200 at another institution?

### STEP 1:

Sign in to Transferology https://www.transferology.com/login.htm

### STEP 2:

Click on the "Find a Replacement Course" tab:



- a. Type under "School You Currently Attend": "Saint Louis University"
- b. Select the correct term under the "Term tab" (Summer of 2026).
- c. Under "Department" select the department you want to take the class from (MATH).

### **STEP 3:**

Scroll down to find MATH 1200 and select it through the plus button.



Click on the button "Search for Matches" on righthand side.



### **STEP 4:**

Type on the search bar and enter the name of the school you want to take the equivalent to MATH 1200. We will use College of DuPage.




It gives me a result that there **IS** a class that will count towards MATH 1200.

### **STEP 5:**

Click on the blue 1 of 1 Match button



The system will show you the class you need to take for it to count towards MATH 1200 and a brief background of the school.



### **Final Result:**

We need to take MATH1428 at College of DuPage for it to count towards MATH 1200 at SLU.
