

The refresher 7.2 course will not satisfy the training requirement on its own. Select the version of the course you want (BIO/BSS/External Collaborator). Note that the External Collaborator course is not for SLU faculty, staff or students or for 7.3 anyone who is routinely conducting research. Click "Finalize registration". Access your course(s) under the Saint Louis 8 University "Courses Ready to Begin" menu. You do not have to complete a course in one sitting.
