

Missouri Voters' Public Opinion: Issue Priorities and Ratings

The following document summarizes the opinions of likely voters in Missouri on issue priorities and ratings of conditions. These results were gathered via SLU/YouGov Poll surveys conducted between 2020 and 2025, and the queried conditions included the economy, schools, crime, race relations, infrastructure, and respondents' health. The SLU/YouGov Poll is a biannual survey of likely Missouri voters aiming to inform policymakers, citizens, and researchers of Missourians' opinions on important issues facing the state.

Over Time Summary: Likely Missouri voters consistently rate both the U.S. and Missouri economies as Fair or Poor from 2020-2025. From February 2024 to February 2025, 15% more voters rated the U.S. Economy as Fair or Poor, while there was little change in the ratings of the Missouri state economy. Most voters rate crime in their community as Fair or poor, but compared to the February 2024 poll, 5% more voters rated crime in their community as Excellent or Good, and 3% more voters rated race relations in their community as Excellent or Good. 66% of voters rate Missouri public schools as Fair or Poor, which is 7% higher than findings from February 2024.
